# Mrs Frost's Message:



Last term was so busy with a long exam period followed by another successful Presentation Evening. Exam results reflected well on all our students so congratulations to each of them and the staff whose careful and dedicated teaching ensures their success. It was very unfortunate that the RAD results were not back in a timely fashion and those students missed out on being acknowledged at Presentation.

Over the holidays our comp students competed in the Southern Dance Festival at Carwatha College. It was an overly long



exhausting 12 days however the students were always a delight to be with and performed exceptionally well. The overall standard of this competition is high with many different schools participating which made it interesting and challenging. Congratulations to all but especially to Melinda Ferenczi who won the senior classical champ with Flynn Stelfox a worthy runner up (he was also runner up in both senior jazz and senior tap – in all cases his first time in a senior level champ.) Flynn also received the aggregate winner for 12 under 14 age meaning he won the most points in this age group over the entire comp. It was also his last comps with us before heading off to the Australian Ballet School

next year. I have taught Flynn from age 3 and shall really miss him but my best wishes go with him on this new part of his journey to become a professional dancer. Also congratulations to Melinda Ferenczi who has been accepted into the Advanced Diploma Course at the Australian Conservatoire of Ballet. Be sure to come see Flynn as Puck and Melinda as a lead fairy in the end of year production of Midsummer Night's Dream!



We had a couple of very productive costume cutting days with just the right amount of help to keep everyone busy. #### **STUDIO CLEANERS REQUIRED**

Whenever possible, we like to use members of our community to perform services that we require. The cleaning of the ballet studios is one of these. Remuneration is made by reducing or waiving the tuition fees. To cater for the numbers using the studios during the week, we prefer that the cleaning is done on two days, Mondays and Thursdays. Cleaning normally takes 3-5 hours and apart from the weekly routine during term, it is also done at appropriate times (by arrangement) during the term holidays. # PROFESSIONAL COSTUME PHOTOS

If you are interested in having a photo of your child in costume, you will need to ensure that you come either 30 mins prior to your rehearsal time, or be prepared to wait after your scheduled rehearsal time for a photo to be taken. The photography can only be taken before/after your child's rehearsal piece, and it is imperative that the rehearsal schedule not be interrupted, as delays will then impact on the running of the whole day.

<u>PART 2</u> - Junior Classical Ballet, and all Jazz, Tap, Contemporary, and Character Dances (ALL GREEN TITLES)

PART 3 - Full Dress Rehearsals/Performance Info - For Everyone! (YELLOW TITLES)

# Part 1 - Midsummer Night's Dream

#### PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING GENERAL POINTS:

- 1. All "MSND" combined rehearsals take place in the neighbouring Community Centre Youth Hall
- 2. All rehearsal lengths are approximate and may not always run to time we regret any inconvenience and keep this to an absolute minimum. If we are running late at the end of the day and you need to take your child due to other commitments you MUST inform a <u>STAFF</u> member before hand so that we know where your child is and he/she MUST be signed out.
- 3. This schedule is not set in gold please ensure you check times each week and LISTEN to your child if they tell you there has been a change putting such a huge ballet together makes it impossible to know exactly how much time will be needed for each scene and rescheduling for optimal use of time is very possible.
- 4. At the end of each rehearsal block "Corrections" are given this is a part of the whole process and is compulsory for all dancers involved. At this time any necessary rehearsal time changes will be decided and noted, and the weekly class/rehearsal times for seniors will also be decided. Obviously younger dancers NOT in the 2<sup>nd</sup> act will NOT have to wait to the end of the day they will be given their information after ACT 1 is completed.
- 5. Where a rehearsal is scheduled as "IN COSTUME" then costumes MUST be worn so ensure they are ready and do not expect staff to be happy if they are not! Potential problems must be ironed out before we get to the theatre and this is only possible if the costumes are worn well in advance.
- 6. At lunch time there is usually a sausage sizzle for all participants at minimal cost. Dancers note that you may NOT eat anything when in costume and no costumes should be worn outside the Community Centre unless crossing between the studio and the Community Hall.
- 7. Female students use the stage area as their dressing room and males use the room (#6) at the side of the hall. We are required to ensure NO MESS REMAINS at the end of every rehearsal. Sadly many students are very messy and NEVER tidy up doubling up the work load of the staff and committee who then have to clean it up. Discuss this with your child and explain the importance of community spirit as well as the need to be tidy and careful with their own and other people's belongings.
- 8. Every year we have issues with headdress and other accessories "disappearing" If your own headdress etc 'disappears" you MAY NOT help yourself to someone else's report the loss to staff and leave it at that. MAKE SURE YOU PUT YOUR OWN HEADDRESS AWAY IN THE DESIGNATED SPOT/WITH YOUR COSTUME WHEN YOU REMOVE IT AND NOT JUST DROP IT ON THE FLOOR!

PLEASE NOTE – Classes and Rehearsal for the week will be called at the end of combined rehearsals. You need to pay attention and be there to find out when you are next required. If for any reason you cannot be there when rehearsals end, it is your responsibility to find out via friends, internet, or phoning the studios. Missing because you 'didn't know' will not be accepted!
