FROM THE ARTISTIC DIRECTOR

There seems to be such a lot to fit into all our lives and I want to thank everyone who is participating and making the concert happen – the ballets (The Queen Bee's Party and Raymonda) have come together so well and I am excited to see all our students performing next week. I am also excited to see all the jazz, tap contemporary and character items! Costumes are almost complete as I write, and sets are looking fabulous. STAGE MAKEUP

Stage Makeup remains the same as previous years. Info is available on the website under the 'Parent Zone' tab. Our recommended brand is 'Motives', but any brand will do as long as the colours are similar -

Foundation – 1 shade darker than skin tone

Eye Shadow – 3 Shades – Dark Brown, Beige and White/Cream. No Shimmers please.

Blush – Brick/Terracotta red, not pink or bright red.

Lipstick – Red (cherry red)

Powder – pressed or loose

Eyelashes – from Level 6 (Raymonda cast) up – medium length

Eye liner – Liquid is recommended – Black.
