Our recommended brand is 'Motives', but any brand will do as long as the colours are similar –

Foundation – 1 shade darker than skin tone – Eye Shadow – 3 Shades – Dark Brown, Beige and White/Cream. No Shimmers please. – Blush – Brick/Terracotta red, not pink or bright red. – Lipstick – Red (cherry red) – Powder – pressed or loose –

Eyelashes – from Level 5 (Sleeping Beauty) up – medium length – Eye liner – Liquid is recommended – Black. – Mascara – Black
